Deadline: April 1st each year.

Please write a letter to the scholarship committee, including the following information:

A. Personal Data

- a. Name
- b. Address
- c. Home / business phone
- d. Email and fax
- e. Local church and pastor
- f. Ministry committee advisor

B. Academic Status

- a. School name
- b. Years completed
- c. Plans for future formal study
- d. Date of expected receipt of M.Div. degree

C. Goal Statement

- a. Brief summary of plans and path to ministry.

D. Financial Situation and Evidence of need.

- a. Current / future scholarships, grants, legacies, local church support, etc.
- b. Financial plan for meeting educational and living expenses (self and family) for the next academic year.
 - i. Loans, spouse/partner income and assets, other assets, savings, jobs and other financial information that the applicant wishes to present to the committee.
(Please be specific in including dollar amounts)

E. Dollar amount of Scholarship aid being requested.

F. Unusual circumstances that should be brought to the committee's attention.

G. Handicaps or disabilities that may affect the applicant's financial situation.

H. Academic Status

- a. A transcript through most recent completed semester
- b. List of courses taken this semester
- c. Course plan for next calendar/academic year.
